STUDENT EXPULSION

Under the authority of the *Public Schools Act*, the Board of Trustees may expel a student from schools in the division on the grounds that his/her conduct is deemed injurious to the welfare of the school. Expulsion is here defined as an exclusion from school by Board motion for a period of longer than six weeks. Exclusion from school for a period less than six weeks is defined as a suspension, and does not require Board motion.
