
Articulation

Key Considerations:

Disconnect in Learning Platforms: Navigate to "Mainstream" (Secondary)
 From Highly Personalized & Inquiry Learning → To Traditional Learning
 FAE – ENTER – COMPASS Program Student Articulation is Challenging

2. Student Online Learning Skills: Grades 4-9 Digital Training is Essential

<u>Required</u> for Life-Long Learning (digital skills, footprint, security, citizenship)
Core delivery platform for employment and post-secondary education

Key Take-Aways



1. Mainstream Blended : The Future of Learning - Embrace It - Resource It

- District promote a positive image for online/blended learning
- Five Year Strategic Plan Blended/Online Learning
- Students: Initiate/teach online learning skills earlier (intermediate level)
 Initiate blended learning platforms in schools throughout the district

2. Enhance Existing District Programming: The Demand/Need is Real
ENTER/E2 – Move to multiple cohort school model (like FAE)

 New Blended Secondary Programs 10–12 (i.e. ThinkSpace, Athletes, Transitions)
- 3. <u>District Planning</u>: Strategic Plan Blended Learning & Navigate Growth
 To shift district culture & instruction 21st C/Personalized Learning
 Dedicated District Administrative Leadership Platform to Guide Development
