Application Dates:

**Dates listed for early admission

- Some PSIs may also have late application dates
- Most PSIs being accepting applications October 1, but some start in September
- Applying early may qualify students for academic achievement scholarships at some universities
- Applying early may lead to early acceptance and first choice for course selections
- Dates listed are not for specific programs EG: nursing has its own application dates & deadlines – check to see if your program has a separate deadline and/or requirements

June 30th, 2016: Recommended deadline to submit Student Loan Application to the Ministry of Advanced Education to ensure receipt of funds by the first day of Fall semester classes.

Entrance Requirements:

- Confirm with your Counsellor that you meet the Entrance Requirements and qualify for admission to the program of your choice
