How to Report Injuries (Employees)

School District No. 71 (Comox Valley)

If a worker is injured in the course of work:

All Injuries:

- All injuries are reported to first aid attendant promptly;
- The first aid attendant completes the first aid records through the Attenance Management System. OHS First Aid Attendant Guide
- Follow steps in appropriate column below

An incident requiring <u>first aid only</u> does not fall under the steps of medical services. <u>Medical services</u> refers to doctor visits as well as physiotherapy, chiropractor, x-ray, massage therapy (which must be preceded by a doctor's visit). If a <u>violent incident</u>, please refer to the Workplace Violence Incident Report and Investigation Flowchart.

If no medical services and no lost work time beyond the day of injury (ie. first aid only):

Injured worker does <u>not</u> receive medical services beyond first aid and there is no lost work time beyond the day of injury.

Documentation ends. The only exception is noted below.

Exception: If the injured worker subsequently receives medical services, then follow steps for medical services received and/or lost work time beyond the day of injury.

If medical services received and/or lost work time beyond the day of injury:

Injured worker receives medical services beyond first aid and/or has lost work time beyond the day of injury.

First aid attendant or injured worker informs worker's supervisor of injury.
