

**Administrative Procedure 6027**

***Police Interviewing of Students***

1. The Board of Education seeks to cooperate with police in investigations, while not compromising the legal rights of the students in its care.
2. Generally, students on school premises or at school-sponsored events are not to be formally interviewed by police officers as part of a formal investigation process.
3. The board recognizes it is possible, due to extenuating circumstances or emergent situations, that a member of the RCMP might need to interview a student as part of a formal investigation. In this case, the attached regulation will apply.
