

Acceptance into the International Student Program is determined by the Coordinator of International Student Program. Students who are accepted will receive initial notification, usually by email. Once fees have been paid, an official Letter of Acceptance will be issued.

Step 6 Study Permit

Once the Letter of Acceptance is received, immediately contact the nearest Citizenship and Immigration Canada office and request a VISA application form for a Study Permit. As this process can exceed eight weeks, please apply early. Please ensure that your passport is current.
